Video Cameras in use at Kennel Club Licensed Events

Photography and Filming

The taking of photographs in the exhibition premises for sale or reward is strictly prohibited except with the written permission of the Organisers. The Organisers reserve the right at their absolute discretion to confiscate cameras and/or films for infringements of this condition.

There is no objection to the general public taking photographs or video film of general views of the Show, provided that these are for private use only. Specific dogs may be photographed only with the approval of the exhibitor. No photography or filming is permitted in breed judging rings whilst judging is actually taking place. However, judges may allow it to happen at the end of classes or after the Challenge Certificate/Best of Sex is awarded.

Filming and flash photography is allowed from outside the rings at all times unless the operation of the camera is actually affecting exhibits. However, if a powerful flash unit is used or it is clear that exhibits are being affected, a ring steward or the judge is empowered to stop the person concerned.

Cinematograph or television equipment may only be used at the Show if a permit has been issued by the Organisers. There are also certain restrictions on the use of cameras for still photography and private video films.

other reason. When a judge withholds a third award for want of merit, the subsequent awards in that class must also be withheld

27. Should the judge be prevented from fulfilling his/her engagement, the Committee reserves to themselves the right to appoint a substitute judge. Exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw from competition, but no entry fees can be returned.
28. The Committee will not be responsible for the loss, detention of or damage to any dogs or other property, whether arising from accident or any other cause whatever, or from any act or omission of themselves, their officers, agents, servants or others, and it is on this understanding only that entries are accepted.
29. The Committee will not be in any way responsible for any claim for injury or compensation occasioned by or arising out of the holding of the Show or by any other reason or the act or default of any person in attendance or present thereat.
30. All persons attending the Show must compensate and/or indemnify the Club for any loss or damage to any property or buildings within the showground caused with or without negligence by any person under the age of 18 years who is brought by them to the Show or for whom they are responsible.
31. **Sale of Dogs and Acceptance of Dogs For Exhibition.** All negotiations for the sale of dogs must be conducted between buyers and sellers. The acceptance of a dog for exhibition shall not be taken to imply that the Committee warrants or guarantees that the dog is in a fit state for exhibition or complies with the Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition and the Committee shall not be liable in any way whatsoever if the dog is subsequently found either to have been unfit for exhibition or not to have complied with the said Regulations.
32. Exhibition of Dogs. a) No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car and caravan parks and approaches. b) The owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at Kennel Club Licensed Events must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car and caravan parks and approaches. This regulation applies before (at any time during the set up period at the venue), during the event and afterwards (at any time during the breakdown of the event)
33. A dog may be disqualified by the Board from any award, whether an objection has been lodged or not, if proved amongst other things to have been a) registered or recorded as having been bred by the scheduled Judge. This shall not apply to a Judge appointed in an emergency; b) exhibited without payment of the appropriate entry fees.
34. Every exhibitor shall ensure that whilst the dog is being exhibited, its handler shall display the correct ring number.
35. Entry forms signed solely by an individual(s) under the age of 18 years as owner(s) of the exhibit(s) must be accompanied by a signed letter accepting responsibility from parent(s) or legal guardian(s).
36. All gangways, fire exits and entrances in the hall **MUST BE KEPT CLEAR AT ALL TIMES**. Any obstructions will be removed by authorised officials. Cages grooming tables and trolleys are not allowed at the ringside.
37. **Supplementary Rules.** All rules and regulations or definitions or instructions in the nature of rules and regulations printed for convenience in other parts of this Schedule shall be deemed to be the Regulations of the Committee and shall have the same effect as if they formed part of these Regulations.
38. **Final Appeals.** Should any question arise not provided for in these Regulations or by Kennel Club Rules the decision of the Committee shall be final subject only to appeal to the Kennel Club.
39. Every exhibitor making an entry or entries in the Show shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by the Kennel Club Rules and Show Regulations and by these Regulations and it is on this understanding only that entries are received.
40. Objections and Protests. Subject to K.C. Show Regulations.

NOTICES TO EXHIBITORS

DIRECTIONS TO VENUE—Post Code RG20 8TE

From the West or East on M4, Leave M4 at J13. Follow A34 signs north (Oxford/Midlands), take first slip road exit left signed Chieveley. At end, turn left & follow for approx. 800m through the village, to venue on your right.

From South (A34 towards Oxford), follow signs for Chieveley & M4 East/West (keep left), go around the roundabout and take sign for Chieveley & A34 north. Take first slip road and follow directions above.

From North (A34), take turn signed to Beedon: follow for approx 3 miles & turn right at East Lane (signed to Chieveley), take next right turn & venue is on the right (approx 100m)

Exercise Area: We are most fortunate to be allowed to hold a Dog Show at this venue. It is most important that the best possible care is taken of the superb facilities offered, in particular by exercising dogs in the designated area with the usual discretion.

Dog Fouling and Grooming Waste: Any owner, competitor or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog(s) at any Kennel Club licensed venue and within the environs of that event including car and caravan parks and approaches. Adequate receptacles for the disposal of such fouling will be provided.

Dogs On Leads: Except when securely benched or caged all dogs must be on a lead for the duration of the Show including in the exercising area, except when competing in the ring in an Obedience Class or Agility Test or taking part in a demonstration.

Dogs in Vehicles on Hot Days: Kennel Club Car & Caravan Park Notice
Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather. Please look after your dog's welfare. Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Warning: if your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

Litter: Exhibitors' help would be very much appreciated in keeping the hall clean and tidy by placing all litter in the receptacles provided. Thank you.

Children: All children must be kept under control and parents will be held responsible for any damage caused and charges incurred.

Disclaimer: The Committee of the show can accept no responsibility for products advertised or sold by stand-holders at the Show and remind exhibitors that grooming products on sale may not meet the requirements of the Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition F(B)

Ring Numbers: Every Exhibitor shall ensure that whilst the dog is being exhibited, its handler shall display the correct ring number.

Identification of Cages/Crates: In accordance with K.C. Guidelines, exhibitors are responsible for and must display exhibit number/owner identification on their cage, crate or container at all times and should note that the original exhibit/bench number card, as provided by the show society, must not be used for this purpose.

PLEASE NOTE

THERE ARE NO CHILD AND JUNIOR HANDLING CLASSES AT THIS SHOW.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.

17. Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under the Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.
18. Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered
19. No modifications will be made to this Schedule except by permission of the Board of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
20. **Entries.** All entries must be made on or before 22nd October 2021 (postmark). Entries received by post not later than 29th October 2021 will be accepted provided they bear a postmark not later than Friday 22nd October 2021. If acknowledgement of entries is required a stamped addressed postcard must be enclosed; this will be signed and returned. In your own interest please use First Class Mail. In the event of any dispute the only admissible evidence of posting on or before the correct date of posting shall be a certificate issued by the Post Office.
21. **Exhibitors passes** will not be sent out.
22. **Animals allowed in Show.** No animal other than an exhibit shall be brought into the precincts of the Show during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the Board.
23. **Exclusion of Dogs.** a. If in the opinion of the Show Secretary, Show Manager or Judge any dog is considered not in a fit state for exhibition owing to disease, savage disposition or any other cause, the dog may be excluded or removed from the Show on the instruction of the Show Management. Once excluded or removed from the Show the dog must not be brought into the Show at any time under any circumstances. b. if in the opinion of the Show Secretary, Show Manager or duly appointed official of the Kennel Club any dog is suffering from a visible condition which adversely affects its health or welfare the dog must be examined by the Veterinary Surgeon of the Show to establish the validity of the allegation. The Veterinary Surgeon's opinion shall be final and if the allegation is upheld, the dog shall be excluded from all subsequent competition at the Show. Where no Veterinary Surgeon is present at the Show the matter should be reported to the K.C. Within 7 days of the close of the Show c. A full report on any exclusion(s) must be made by the Show Secretary to the Kennel Club for consideration within 7 days of the close of the show.
24. **Exhibition of Dogs suffering from contagious or infectious disease or any visible condition which adversely affects their health or welfare.** No dog suffering from any infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Show or suffering from any visible condition which adversely affects its health or welfare may be exhibited. Exhibitors infringing this Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or to be dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A11.
25. Except when securely benched or caged all dogs must be on a lead for the duration of the Show including in the exercising area, except when competing in the ring in an Obedience Class or Agility Test or taking part in a demonstration.
26. **Judging.** A Judge's awards shall be final except in the case of fraud or misrepresentation or where a bona fide mistake has been made by the Judge. No alteration of the awards may be made after the day of the Show without specific permission of the Kennel Club. An award may be withheld if in the opinion of the judge there is lack of sufficient merit. The judge must mark on the judging slips that the award has been so withheld. The judge is not entitled to withhold an award for any

6. **Prize Money** The amount of prize money on offer at this show is BIS £10, RBIS £5, BPIS £5.
7. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
8. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
9. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
10. **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW.** Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and is unbeaten by any other puppy exhibited at the same show. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best in Show is a puppy it should automatically be awarded Best Puppy in Show respectively. Where the Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it should also automatically be Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best in Show respectively.
11. **BEST IN SHOW** must be selected from the exhibits declared Best Of Sex. If a Reserve Best in Show is to be selected the eligible dogs are those declared Best Opposite Sex and Reserve Best Of Sex to the exhibit declared Best In Show.
12. Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
13. Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not to touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
14. All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
15. **OVERSEAS EXHIBITORS.** All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show / event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor
16. **DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS**
Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
 - When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
 - If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
 - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
 - Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
 - When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
 - Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
 - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

## DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

*(The word 'dog' includes both sexes)*

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club.

Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows.

In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society.

In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of postal entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. Friday 15<sup>th</sup> October 2021

Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering for Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A first prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

(1) Withdrawal The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulation F(1)19

2. Transfer

- a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy, Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.
- b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy Class, Puppy Class or Junior Class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or twenty-four calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy Class, Junior class or Yearling Class respectively for the correct colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling Class to the Open Class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.
- c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.
- d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

**MINOR PUPPY** For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

**PUPPY** For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**JUNIOR** For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**YEARLING** For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty-four calendar months of age on the first day of the show.

**MAIDEN** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or a First Prize at an Open or Championship Show (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

**NOVICE** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or three or more First Prizes at Open and Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not.)

**GRADUATE** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open Classes, whether restricted or not. at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed

**POST GRADUATE** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**LIMIT** For dogs which have not become show Champions under the Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club, or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won 7 or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes confined to the Breed, whether restricted or not at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**OPEN** For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

**VETERAN** For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

**BRACE** For two exhibits (either sex or mixed) of one breed belonging to the same exhibitor, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

**SPECIAL STUD DOG (PROGENY CLASS)** For a dog accompanied by at least three of its registered progeny. The dog need not necessarily have been entered in another breed class but all progeny having been entered and exhibited in another breed class at the Show. The dog and the progeny need not be registered in the same ownership. The progeny must be direct sons and/or daughters of the dog entered.

**SPECIAL BROOD BITCH (PROGENY CLASS)** For a bitch accompanied by at least three of its registered progeny. The bitch need not necessarily have been entered in another breed class but all progeny having been entered and exhibited in another breed class at the Show. The bitch and the progeny need not be registered in the same ownership. The progeny must be direct sons and/or daughters of the bitch entered.

**NOT FOR COMPETITION** Societies may at their discretion, accept Not for Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dogs not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed. (NFC Entries will be accepted for dogs of **SIX** calendar months of age and over on the first day of the show.)

## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The show will open at 10.am
2. Dogs will be received until 12.00 noon after which no dogs may be received except under exceptional and unforeseen circumstances and by any special permission of the Show Management. It is the exhibitors responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
3. Judging will commence at 11.00am.
4. Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
5. **Entry Fees:** Members £6 for the first class entered with each dog and £2 for the second and each subsequent class entered with the same dog. Not for Competition £6 per dog. Non-Members £7 for the first class entered with each dog and £2 for the second and each subsequent class entered with the same dog. Not for Competition £7 per dog. Brace Class: £2 per brace. No entries will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entry fees and such fees will NOT be refunded once an entry has been made.

**ADDITIONAL CHARGES.** An administration charge of £3 will be levied against the exhibitor for any correction to entry fees or entry forms. Requested alterations to entry forms must be in writing and signed by the exhibitor. These are only permitted up to the entries close date, at the discretion of the Committee. No alterations will be accepted after this date. There will be a charge of £10 made to the exhibitor for any cheques not honoured.

**Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog.**

**If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.**

**REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION  
Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B)**

1. These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club licensed event. Objections may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A 11
  - a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.
  - b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations, then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A 11
2. a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the Show.
  - b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except
  - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the Board
  - (b) The removal of dewclaws of any breed;
  - (c) Operations to prevent breeding providing that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.Nor must anything be done calculated in the opinion of the Board to deceive.
4. The Board without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate) to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint
